Scheduling and Cost Control

Develop effective measures for scheduling and controlling projects as you put the tools of project management to work. In this course you'll focus on managing the constraints you face in any project: limits on time, human resources, materials, budget and specifications.

Scheduling and Cost Control for Federal Government Projects

This course reviews best practices to meet the requirements of OMB A-94 and A-11 and addresses the entry-level business, cost, and financial management competencies and performance outcomes, as defined by the FAC-P/PM policy and competency model.
