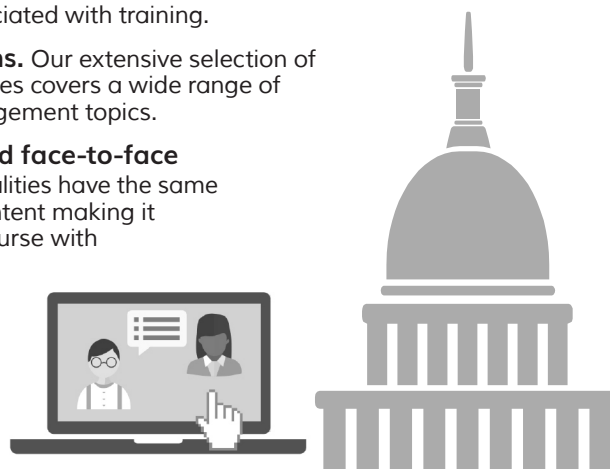

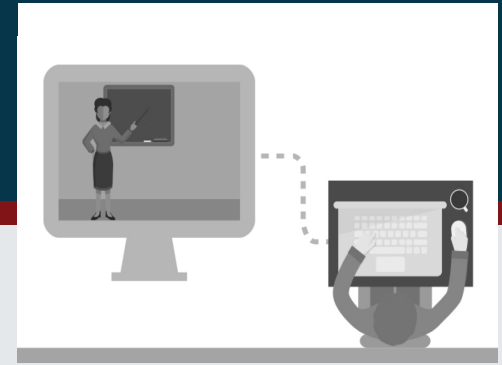

Live and Collaborative Learning, Virtually

With real-time delivery in a live, online format, TwentyEighty Strategy Execution's Virtual Classroom option lets your agency students communicate with instructors and collaborate with fellow classmates.

Virtual classroom delivery takes the convenience of our popular e-Training modality and combines it with the interactivity and immediacy of our face-to-face classroom courses, offering a real-time learning experience in a live, online format.

Virtual Instructor-Led Classroom courses are structured just like our traditional classroom courses, providing a wide range of collaborative learning tools:

- **Communication and interactive tools.**
The instructor and participants communicate in real time via microphone and text-chat and stay engaged with a multitude of interactive tools. Polling questions, surveys, quiz questions and games spark discussion and reinforce key learning points while markup tools and whiteboards allow for brainstorming and sharing of experiences.
- **Breakout rooms.**
In most modules, participants are divided into virtual breakout rooms to collaboratively solve case studies and complete exercises, much like they would in the traditional classroom.
- **Offline homework.**
Participants complete homework assignments and exercises outside of the classroom to help them further retain and apply new information and prepare for the final exam.
- **Reinforcement tools.**
During and after the course, students can access valuable tools, templates, readings, reference material, and homework assignments.

Classroom Quality Training - Anytime, Anywhere

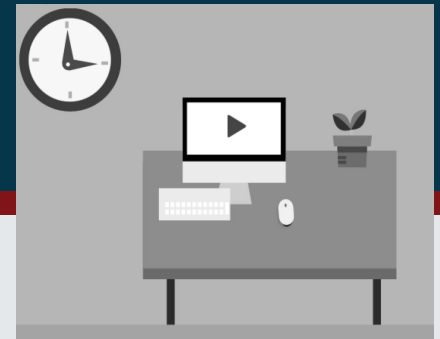
TwentyEighty Strategy Execution's E-Training option is an easy way to get courses your agency needs anytime, anywhere, for any amount of students.

VIRTUAL CLASSROOM VS. E-TRAINING: WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE?

Online learning is not only beneficial from a cost-saving perspective. Modern tech-savvy employees relate to digital training because it often fits their habits and lifestyle. More and more government agencies offer work environments with flexible hours, telecommuting from different locations, or the chance to work from home.
